STANFINS CASE STUDY



OVERVIEW -

The Standard Finance System (STANFINS) is one of the Army's many legacy accounting systems being divested to the new financial management and accounting tool, the General Fund Enterprise Business System (GFEBS). The Temporary Change of Station Travel (TCS) is a key financial transaction still posting in STANFINS that prevents the system from being fully divested. Intrepid's STANFINS team led the effort to reengineer how TCS transactions are being posted to allow the full divestiture of STANFINS and move the Army one step closer to a modernized enterprise system.
